I STATE:

☐ I submitted a certificate accrediting that I have the level of Catalan required to be a member of the teaching staff of the URV before I sat the test to be admitted to the recruitment process.

☐ I will demonstrate that I have the required level of Catalan after I sit the test to be admitted to the recruitment process, in application of article 3.7 of Decree 128/2010. ([Application](#))

In this case, the applicant must demonstrate to Vice-Rector for Teaching and Research Staff that they have the right for this article to be applied to them. If the Vice-Rector believes that admitting this applicant will strengthen and promote the recruitment of talented staff and that the linguistic rights of the students will be guaranteed, the applicant will be allowed to compete for the position. If the applicant is awarded the place, they must accredit their knowledge of the language within a maximum of two years as of the date on which they joined the university by any of the aforementioned mechanisms.
